Content of our analysis in the project youth- and culturwork from Leuphana University Lueneburg is the field of living- conditions from young people. Actually we analyse the situation of youth work in a town with 30.00 inhabitants called Achim. Offers and institutions for young people are not very effective and attractive for them. Therefore we worked out a useful concept. We want to combine outreach youth work, constant rooms (used by young people) and structures of self- organisation. In this concept we needed to change the structure of workplaces. At this moment the concept is implementing into practice. For the IP Programm in Slovenia we tried to find out structures in Achim, how we can support volunteers. For the constant rooms, the projects or the youth parliament we need young people who are responsible for different tasks and feel motivated to engage.
